Key steps to the ABCHumboldt method

1. Placement test and needs analysis

On the first day at ABCHumboldt, students do a test to determine their current level of Spanish. The test consists of two parts: written and oral. If they wish, our students can do the written part on our website and the oral part on Skype before starting the course. Before students arrive, a needs analysis is performed in order to define course objectives.

2. Uniform groups

Students are then placed in a group at an appropriate level to ensure the success of their learning.

3. Learning materials

The materials used in training classes are designed to stimulate Spanish learning. We use the most up-to-date textbooks and modern facilities, with the very latest multimedia and online learning options.

4. Ongoing support and monitoring

Students' progress is monitored closely and constantly by our Academic Coordinator and their teachers.

5. Diploma and certificates

Students receive an attendance or progress certificate at the end of the course. We certify their language proficiency level.

Spanish Language Courses

Group Courses

All courses are grouped according to level of ability, ranging from A1-Beginner to C2-Superior; all follow the guidelines of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and the curriculum of the Instituto Cervantes. Our students can attend for free our “Conversation Class & Press Review” (daily) Training classes are held from Monday to Friday, mornings or afternoons, depending on various factors such as level, number of students/groups, etc. Training classes start every Monday throughout the month, but absolute beginners must start on the first Monday of each month (in July and August only, the third Monday is also possible).



Standard Intensive

The Intensive Course is designed to provide a thorough knowledge of general Spanish at all levels. This course is for students who want to improve their Spanish language skills for general use. Group sizes are small (maximum 12 students), so joining a course here is about participating. The courses are lively and fun, helping students pick up the language right from day one. The course covers the basic skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing, and is specially programmed to improve practical Spanish language skills as quickly as possible. Intensive Spanish courses are from one to 11 weeks' duration, and students may extend their course over the number of weeks required.

Long Term

The minimum course duration is 12 weeks. This is the ideal programme for students who are able to study Spanish during an extended stay, leading to fluent understanding and the ability to communicate at all times. This programme also allows our students to be immersed in the cultural, political, historical, economic and social aspects of Spanish life, thus getting to feel like Spaniards.

Academic Semester and Year

These programmes are designed for students wishing to study for a long period of time at ABCHumboldt. The Academic Semester is 24 weeks of tuition and the Academic Year is 32 weeks of tuition. This is the best option for those students who want to take a gap year or simply immerse themselves in Spanish life and culture. The Academic Year can be structured to suit each individual student's needs. Our Academic Coordinator can design a suitable study path, taking into consideration the student's arrival time, level of Spanish and academic aim for the year.

Intensive Minigroups

International groups with a maximum of 4 participants offer the ideal setting for learning Spanish in a communicative way. These interactive training classes are held in uniform learning groups. The course develops practical skills, such as Spanish for presentations, as well as general communication skills. Course length from one to 32 weeks/20 classes per week.

Group Courses

Combined Courses: Group course plus one-to-one tuition

Combination of a Group Course (Standard Intensive or Intensive Minigroup) plus one-to-one tuition. A combined course offers an excellent opportunity to blend group-based general Spanish training classes with the personal attention that comes from one-to-one tuition. We offer either 5 or 10 classes per week of one-to-one tuition, during which the student can focus on general or business Spanish, or prepare for an examination such as DELE, telc or the Cámara de Comercio de Madrid's Business Spanish. Spanish training classes.

We hold free "Conversation Class & Press Review" every day for all our students. This serves as a warm-up.



DELE Preparation

Our examination preparation courses are designed to help students use their language abilities to get the best possible grade in DELE examinations. On these courses, students learn about how the examinations work and what the examiners will be looking for. The content focuses on the DELE qualifications (Diplomas in Spanish as a Foreign Language), the official qualifications awarded by the Instituto Cervantes to certify competence and proficiency in Spanish. ABCHumboldt is recognised as an official examining centre for DELE.

DELE examination dates: May, August and November.

Special Programmes

Junior Summer Course

The course is designed for students aged 15 to 18. It combines Spanish training classes (Standard Intensive Course) with a wide range of social and cultural activities, thus facilitating language learning while our students thoroughly enjoy their stay in Barcelona.

Students can choose to take a two, three or four-week course. Training classes are held in the morning or afternoon. Activities take place from 17:00 onwards, always accompanied by an ABC Humboldt guide. The objective of this programme is to ensure our students have an unforgettable fun-filled Barcelona experience.

We trust that our students will enjoy learning as much as possible about Spain, its language and culture.

For this reason, we offer organised activities every afternoon from Monday to Friday and excursions on Saturdays.

These activities are specially designed for our junior students and include cultural events, sports and recreation.

Students participating in this course benefit from particularly close monitoring to ensure that their stay is as safe as possible.

Sample of a two-week programme

First week

Monday: Introductory talk about the course and Barcelona, followed by a walk around the city centre.

Tuesday: Beach games and swimming.

Wednesday: Tour of the Sagrada Familia temple, a spectacular example of Gaudí's architecture.

Thursday: Walk to Montjuïc castle, with panoramic views of the city. Later, a tour of the spectacular Montjuïc fountain to see the music and light show.

Friday: Barcelona legends tour.

Saturday: Excursion to Figueres (Girona province) to visit the unique surrealist Salvador Dalí museum.

Second week

Monday: Tour of Camp Nou and the FC Barcelona museum.

Tuesday: Bowling.

Wednesday: Tour of Gaudí's Park Güell.

Thursday: Barcelona museums (Picasso, Miró, MACBA, CCCB).

Friday: Barcelona waterfront.

Saturday: Excursion to Sitges, a typical Mediterranean coastal town.

Special Programmes

Spanish for Your Own Group

Spanish courses specially designed for the specific needs of each group: language or cultural school trips, a group of students with the same interests, a language business trip, etc.

The start date of the course, number of weeks and classes per week are flexible. Training classes can be held in open groups (with other students at the school, according to level) or closed groups (your group only).

For closed groups, all the participants in the group must have the same or similar levels of Spanish.

Requirements

Minimum of 6 participants.

Maximum of 12 participants per group class.

Groups of students under the age of 18 must be accompanied by group leaders over the age of 18.

Training class may be scheduled for mornings or afternoons.

Closed groups can establish the exact dates on which they wish to have training classes.



Social and cultural activities (optional)

Activities can take place in open groups (with other students) or closed groups (your group only).

Weekday activities (from Monday to Friday only):

Gothic Quarter tour, Park Güell tour, Modernist tour, Montjuic tour, Salsa classes, Flamenco show, Barcelona waterfront, Barcelona Legends tour, Las Ramblas, Cultural Night tour, Camp Nou, Bike tour, La Pedrera, La Sagrada Familia, train trip to Cavas Freixenet, Picasso museum.

Excursions (Saturdays only): Montserrat and Sitges/ Cavas Freixenet, Dalí museum and Girona/Costa Brava, Tarragona, Monasterio de Santes Creus.

Accommodation (optional)

We have a great deal of experience in the organization of accommodation for groups.

We offer accommodation with Spanish host families (the best way to keep practicing Spanish outside the classroom) or in residences (for lodging the whole group at the same place, something very useful for the group leader).

In both, we offer breakfast only, half board or full board (picnic for lunch), in single or double rooms.

Special accommodation discounts for leaders.

Meeting and transfer services (optional)

Arrival and/or departure transfers from/to Barcelona airport to/from the accommodation or school by private coach, with a school representative in attendance on arrival.

If the group is accommodated in homestays, on the day of arrival, host families will be at the school when the coach arrives to accompany students to their respective accommodations.

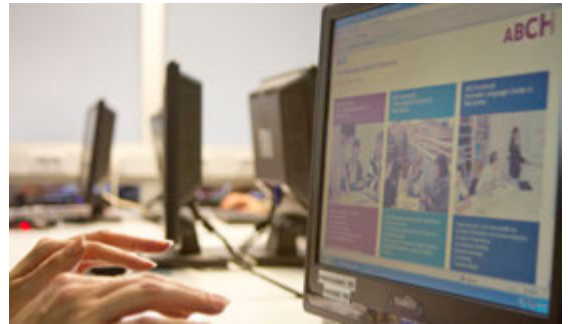
Private individuals who would like to learn Spanish over a short period of time or improve their communicative skills in general Spanish.

1:1. Business Spanish

Our business language training in Spanish is the most frequently chosen Spanish course by international managers and executives. The programme is drawn up according to the student's professional objectives. We prepare the student, systematically and with specific teaching materials, for conversations, talks and negotiations in Spanish.

1:1 Intercultural Coaching: Working and living in Spain

Our intercultural coaching for Spain is a practical way to get to know Spanish business culture and provides students with an insight into new business environments. It will help students to understand cultural differences and to use them productively and creatively. Seminars can be held in English, Spanish, Italian or German.



Online Courses: Spanish online

For students who would like to improve Spanish at work or in the comfort of their own home. With our e-learning facilities that focus on individual learning requirements, the student is in control, anytime, anywhere. Seminar 2: Presentations and Meetings

A number of key aspects are analysed, such as the use of language in presentations, the structure of presentations and the role of participants, taking real presentations as the basis.

Objective: To learn how to prepare, give and conclude a presentation using effective language and developing strategies for business meetings.

Minimum level required: B1

Seminar 3: Negotiating in Spanish

These seminars focus on the language of negotiations, as well as the strategies employed to reach particular objectives through the use of language. In this seminar, participants will experience the process of negotiation through real cases, using their language skills and appropriate linguistic devices.

Objective: To improve and use communication skills and knowledge in professional negotiation situations. To increase confidence and fluency in negotiations and reasoning with international speakers.

Minimum level required: B1

Teaching staff

All our teachers have university degrees, are trained to teach Spanish and have a extensive experience of teaching it. Students will find skilled conversation partners in their course leaders: they speak several languages, have lived abroad and have experience in a wide range of business backgrounds.

Many have additional qualifications in specialist subject areas and have been working at our school for many years.

Students have told us about the quality of our teachers in satisfaction surveys: their annual score is 3.6 on a scale of 1 to 4. ABCHumboldt has a specific external and in-house training programme for teachers and staff; it ensures that our team's skills are continuously improving.

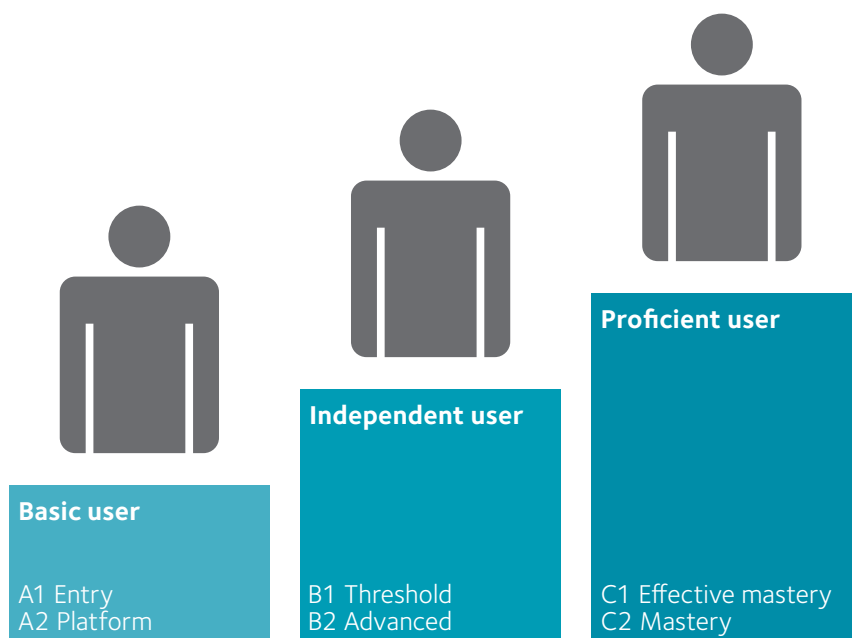
We have project groups that produce original new materials, update examinations and test the possibilities that new communication technologies have to offer in terms of enhancing the teaching-learning process.



Our levels

The school offers a wide range of levels from absolute beginners to very advanced (from A1 to C2). You will normally need at least 100 hours' tuition at any one level before advancing to the next course. The table gives an idea of how our levels compare to those established by the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, the Instituto Cervantes for its DELE qualifications (Diplomas in Spanish as a Foreign Language) and by telc.

The Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) for Languages is the methodology-teaching guide for the ABCHumboldt curriculum and assessment.

Accommodation

For almost all of our students the quality and type of accommodation is just as important as the choice of course - after all, a significant amount of time will be spent there. Our experience has enabled us to put together different categories of accommodation. We would like you to feel as comfortable as possible, at home, with us and in our city, during your language trip to Spain.

Homestay

All host families are selected by ABCHumboldt. We recommend this form of accommodation as being the most comfortable and also the best way to keep practicing Spanish outside the classroom.

- Near the school (walking distance or by public transport, maximum 20 minutes).
- Single and double rooms.

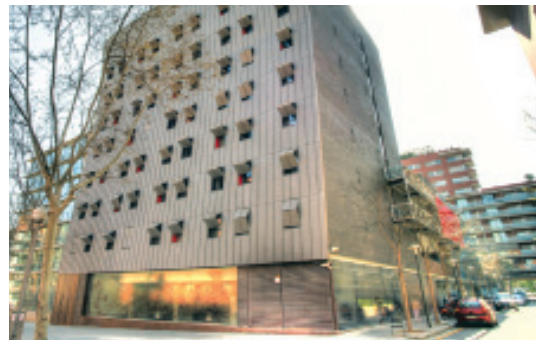

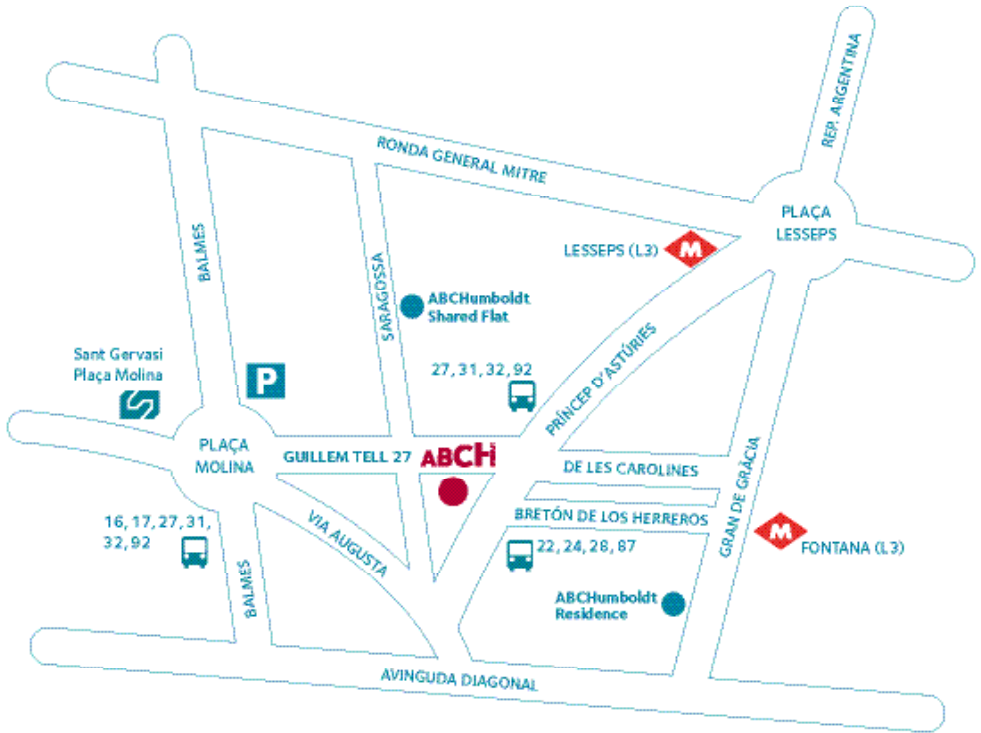
